

Cardiff U3A Walking Programme

September 3rd 2019 to January 21st 2020

Tuesday 3rd September - Llanharan

Description - This is a 5-mile walk, with a steep track uphill to the Ridgeway path, and then on to the hills above Llanharan (great views but no steep drops). The walk then goes past the wind farm and down to Brynna.

The return is along a disused railway track through Brynna woods.

Parking - Meet in the Llanharan railway station car park on Chapel Road (CF72 9QA) at 10.30.

Directions - Leave the M4 at Junction 34 and follow the A4119 towards Talbot Green. At the roundabout, turn left onto the A473 to Llanharan. In Llanharan, follow the signs to the station car park on the right, before the railway bridge.

Lunch - Bryncae Arms - CF72 9RP. Arrangements for pre-booking meals will be made later. **Leaders**

Tuesday 1st October - Cefn Onn to the Maen Llwyd

Description - This walk involves a long climb onto the ridge and then easy walking to the Maen Llwyd. After Lunch, the walk continues back to Cefn Onn Park.

Parking - Meet in the Cefn Onn car park at 10.30 - CF14 OEP.

Directions - Follow the road to Llanishen and then turn up Heol Hir Road and then right onto Excalibur Drive. Follow the road to a roundabout and cross it to the entrance of the park.

Tuesday 15th October - Usk

Description - This is a 4.5 mile walk, along the river Usk then through Cwm Cayo and returning through Lady Hill Wood, passing the site of the battle of Pwll Melyn, and then on to Usk Castle. We will visit the castle if there is time (£2 donation). No stiles.

Parking - Meet in the free Maryport Street North car park at 10.30 - NP15 1EO.

Directions - Leave the M4 at Junction 24 and take the A449 (towards Monmouth), then turn Left on to the A472 to Usk. In Usk, follow the signs to the Information Centre.

Tuesday 29th October - Merthyr Mawr

Description- This is a walk with a difference. Matt Carroll of Swansea U3A will take us on a short walk of discovery, looking for animal evidence and listening to bird song - techniques that can be used elsewhere.

Cost = £1.50 to cover the Leader's expenses.

Parking - Meet in the dunes car park at Merthyr Mawr at 10.30. This is usually a Pay & Display car park.

Directions - This is one option: Take the M4 to Junction 35 and then follow the A473 through 2 roundabouts. At the next roundabout, follow the A48 through 2 roundabouts. Then drive for a very short distance before turning left on to the Merthyr Mawr road

NB. This turning can be easily missed. Follow the signs for Merthyr Mawr to the sand dunes car park.

Tuesday 5th November - Pontyclun and Talygarn

Description - This is a 5-mile walk through Pontyclun woods and the Talygarn estate - moderate walk.

Parking - Meet outside Pontyclun Library, next to the school, at 10.30 - CF72 98E.

Directions - Follow the M4 to Junction 34 and take the 3rd exit towards Llantrisant. At the second set of Lights bear left at the garage and follow the signs for Pontyclun. Drive past the shops and turn left opposite the Masonic Hall, signposted the Library. Park on the roadside away from the school.

Lunch - To be arranged.

Tuesday 19th November - Radyr and Morganstown

Description - This is an easy, flat circular walk of about 4.5 miles through Radyr Woods and along the Taff Trail.

Parking- Meet in the Ty Nant car park, Morganstown (CF15 8LB) at 10.30. Please park in the top car park.

Directions - The Ty Nant is directly opposite Pugh's Garden Centre. Leave the A470 at the Radyr exit and follow Radyr signs. Turn right at the traffic lights after the Garden Centre and then right again into the car park.

Alternatively, approaching from Llantrisant Road (A4119), follow the Radyr signs and drive through Radyr and Morganstown. The Ty Nant will be on your left.

Also, the Number 63 bus from Cardiff runs every 20 minutes and stops in Morganstown near the Ty Nant.
